



Hallmoor Key Stage 4 Art and Design Long Term Plan Formal and Bridge

In Key stage 4 at Hallmoor School, our pupils will partake in obtaining an Entry Level Certificate in Art and Design. There are two components and areas of assessment to the course: (1) Portfolio- internally set, (2) Examination- externally set.

Pupils will be given the opportunity to build their experience, skills and ideas through internally set briefs and this will lead to pupils gaining knowledge and understanding of how to create a journey of work and develop from personal starting points. Learners will explore the work of inspiring artists and are encouraged to explore processes, materials and techniques that are appropriate to the chosen areas of study, in a range of practical ways. This will prepare them for Component two consisted of an externally set brief, for which pupils will demonstrate a personal response.

KS4 Subject Content

There are four Assessment Objectives in OCR's Entry Level Certificate in Art and Design.

In this programme of study pupils are expected to demonstrate their ability to:

AO1- Develop their ideas through investigations informed by the work of others and relevant sources, demonstrating contributions to the making of practical work.

AO2- Refine and explore their ideas through experimenting and using resources, media, materials, techniques and processes.

AO3- Record ideas, observations and imagination relevant to their intentions in visual and/or other forms.

AO4- Present a personal and meaningful response, showing understanding of the work of others, reaching conclusions that relate intentions to purpose.

Aims:

- actively engage with the creative processes of art, craft and design develop, through their studies, to be reflective thinkers with enquiring minds
- develop their creative and imaginative capabilities when exploring, creating and producing their outcomes.

- develop confidence in taking risks and learning from their experiences through exploring and experimenting with ideas, processes, materials, techniques, including traditional and new/ digital media.
- develop knowledge and understanding of art, craft and design in historical and contemporary contexts.
- develop an awareness of the different work practices and roles of the creative and cultural industries in the production of art, craft and design.
- demonstrate safe working practices in art, craft and design.
