In Key stage 4 at Hallmoor School, our pupils will gain recognition of their achievements through partaking in the AQA Unit Award Scheme (UAS).

Pupils will be given the opportunity to build their experience, skills using media tools and equipment and they will be presented with a certificate on completion of an internally set Unit of work. The units of work have been selected so the work they are doing is based upon Level 1 or Level 2 BTEC course in Creative Media, the work and assessment is more accessible for our learners.

Learners will explore different forms of media, and experience different forms of media that are appropriate to each area of study including preparing them with valuable life skills including, forming an opinion, following a method or process and making decisions

The Media AQA Unit Award scheme will enable learners to:

- engage in learning which is relevant to them and will provide opportunities to develop a range of skills and techniques, personal skills and attributes essential for successful performance in working life
- prepare for employment in a particular vocational sector
- progress to related general and/or vocational qualifications.
