



## Hallmoor Key Stage 4 Outdoor Learning Long Term Plan

In Key Stage 4 at Hallmoor School, students who choose Outdoor as an option will partake in obtaining a Pre-Entry or Entry Level qualification from AQA Unit Award Schemes. Within this option, pupils will be given the opportunity to build their experience, skills, and ideas through different schemes of work that will enable them to learn about a mixture of topics.

The Key Stage 4 curriculum uses Unit Awards that are based on the topics from the Key Stage 2 national curriculum.
